#### About Cuvée Louise

Our Cuvée Louise is a very special bottling and extremely rare in its production. Each vintage, Véronique focuses on a few favorite barrels that, once nurtured and artfully blended, will become Louise. Seamless, complex, layered, and deeply pleasing, it is a rare and decidedly wonderful wine.

### The Vintage

Our run of exceptional vintages here in Oregon continues with 2018. The season started on a slightly wet and cool note leading to a late bud break, but caught up quickly. After dry weather and occasional heat spikes in July and August, the end of summer brought comfortable temperatures, a little rainfall, and the perfect setup for harvest.

Harvest Dates: September 28 - October 10, 2018 Louise Bottling Date: February 10, 2020

### Véronique's Tasting Notes

The 2018 Louise has a charming but serious approach. The wine brims with cassis and red cherries and there is a welcome, toasted spice component, along with a savory, smoky oak note that adds to the complexity. Its texture is both luxurious and plush, lifted by notes of ruby plum and black cherry, leading to a spicy and persistent finish. The finesse and length are already impressive, as is Louise's expressiveness and seamlessness. If you have patience, you will be well rewarded as the flavors and depth evolve over the next 10+ years.
